GSGCNWI Troop/Service Unit Camping

Camping with your troop or Service unit provides an opportunity to create new friendships and enhance your Girl Scout experience and is available at all of our camps year round. During June, July and August, Resident Camp and Day Camp program is run at several of the camps. Troop and Service unit camping is available at Camp River Trails and Friendship Center during these months.

Rental applications must be submitted at least **4** weeks before desired use date. It is recommended that you submit your reservation requests early to ensure confirmation. The **Property Rental Application** link can be found on the "Ways to Camp" page.

Your completed Property Rental Application can be emailed to property@girlscoutsgcnwi.org, faxed to 312-750-0718 or mailed to GSGCNWI, 20 S. Clark, Suite 200, Chicago, IL 60603, and Attn: Property Registration. Be sure to include your recreation choices at this time and the \$25 application processing fee.

Once a completed Property Rental Application and \$25 application fee have been received, a packet containing a *Site Use Agreement* and other appropriate paperwork will be forwarded to you within 2 weeks. To secure your reservation, a signed *Site Use Agreement* and the specified payment amount must be returned by the date identified in your packet. A sample *Site Use Agreement* can be viewed on the "Ways to Camp" page by clicking the GSGCNWI **Site Use Agreement** link.

To secure your reservation, a signed copy of the *Site Use Agreement* and the specified payment amount must be received by the date listed in your packet.

To use a campsite, an adult in your troop or service unit will need to complete Outdoor Training 1. If you would like to build a fire, Outdoor Module training 2 and 3 are required. Validation of this training must be on file **30** days before arrival at camp.

It will also be necessary for an adult trained in first aid/ CPR to be with your troop or service unit at all times during your stay at camp. Validation of their certification must be on file **30** days before arrival at camp.

Confirmation of your final recreation participant number is required **30** days before arrival at camp.

Final payment must be made at least 14 days before arrival at camp.

Upon arrival at camp, a completed roster for your group will be required by the Property Host at check in. A copy of the roster can be downloaded using the **GSGCNWI Roster** link located on the "Ways to Camp" page.
