



## Volunteer Led Day Camps

Each day camp has a unique theme and specialized activities; many volunteer-led day camps feature leadership opportunities for older girls and an overnight for interested campers. These camps utilize a variety of sites for their programming. Many are located at state and county parks, while others take place at established camps.

All volunteer-led day camps are supported by council staff to ensure they meet numerous standards regarding program, budgeting, risk management, and health and safety. Registration is handled by each day camp, or you may register online.

Volunteer-led day camps rely on adult volunteers to participate in all aspects of the camp program. Without you, these camps are unable to serve the girls in the community.
