



Important Rewards and Troop Proceeds Dates

Jan 1-21

- Junior, Cadette, Senior and Ambassador troops determine their proceed plan

Jan 23

- Troops submit Initial Reward Orders

Mar 27

- All troops submit Final Reward Orders
- Junior, Cadette, Senior and Ambassador troops confirm their troop proceed plan and submit final reward orders

Information

- **IMPORTANT!** Only Junior, Cadette, Senior and Ambassador Girl Scout troops will be offered a troop proceed option. All Daisy and Brownie Girl Scouts will earn rewards.
- Junior, Cadette, Senior and Ambassador troops that elect to receive more money and no rewards must click the checkbox in eBudde under the SETTINGS tab. If the checkbox is not checked, eBudde will automatically calculate rewards earned for each girl. Once the final reward order is submitted the proceed plan cannot be changed
- Rewards are cumulative.
- eBudde will automatically calculate each girl's rewards. At some of the levels, choices are required. If a reward choice is offered to a girl, please confirm those selections have been completed.
- Each troop must submit the INITIAL and FINAL rewards regardless of troop proceed option for Junior, Cadette, Senior and Ambassador troops.
- Service Unit Cookie Managers must confirm that each troop reward order has been submitted prior to submitting the service unit reward orders.
- Once the troop final reward orders are placed, no changes can be made to the troop proceeds checkbox.
- ALL troops and ALL girls are eligible for the Girl Initial Order Rewards and Troop Rewards.
- Unclaimed rewards must be returned to the council by no later than June 30.
- If a troop manager has not picked up the rewards, contact the leader as soon as possible. It is our responsibility to get the rewards to the girls – they worked hard for them and are expecting them!
- Changes or corrections to girl and troop accounts will be allowed until the last day of the program. Once eBudde is "turned off" to troop and service unit volunteers NO changes or corrections can be made to girl cookie or reward orders.

Rewards and Troop Proceeds

Troops will be excited to know that the reward program includes 16 levels! And all rewards are cumulative! Refer to the back of the order card for a detailed description of the entire reward lineup!

Girl Initial Order Reward

In order to qualify for initial rewards, girls must have sold 120+ packages of cookies by the close of the initial order period. Girls who sell 120+ packages during their initial order will receive a “S’mores Sticky Note Pad” and girls who sell 150+ packages in their initial order will also receive a “S’mores Keepsake.” Initial order totals reported per girl must not be changed after Jan. 23, 2018. For example, if a girl reports selling 120 packages of cookies during the initial order, she must have sold a minimum of 120 packages by the end of the cookie program.

Troop Reward

This year, all troops will be automatically opted into rewards. As a reminder, Daisies and Brownies receive \$0.90 and rewards; Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors and Ambassadors are offered a proceed option - \$0.90 per package and rewards, or \$1 per package and no rewards. Opting out of rewards must happen prior to March 27; once final rewards are submitted, the proceed plan cannot be changed.

Troops with a per girl average (PGA Selling as indicated on the sales report in eBudde™) of at least 140 packages at the end of the program will receive a “Samoas Earbud Pouch.” Plus, each girl participating in troops who reach the per girl average of at least 160 packages will receive a “Seas the Day Tshirt” (size must be selected). The troop will also earn one Hero Trunk Organizer for the troop cookie manager (1 per troop).

The PGA is automatically calculated in eBudde™ according to the number of packages sold by the troop, divided by the number of girls selling. eBudde™ only counts the number

Gift of Caring (GOC) Reward

Girls who sell 15+ packages for GOC will receive a special GOC patch. Girls who sell 30+ packages for GOC will also receive the “Altogether Awesome Bracelet Set.”

CEO for the Day

The five girls who sell the most cookies in our council will enjoy the opportunity to be CEO for a day on Oct. 8, 2018. Other opportunities for COOKIE CEOs occur at various other times throughout the year as well.

Service Unit Incentive

- Service units that reach 100 percent of their council goal will receive \$0.07 per case for every case sold.
 - Service units that reach 100 percent of their fall product and 100 percent of their cookie goal will earn \$0.12 per case.
 - If the service unit achieves 105 percent of their cookie goal and 100 percent of their fall product goal, the service unit incentive amount is increased to \$0.25 per case sold.
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
