## **Daisy Leaf & Badge Workshops**

#### **Count It Up Leaf** (2 hours)

When you take part in the Girl Scout Cookie Program, you are helping with the largest business run by girls in the whole world. When you earn your Count It Up leaf you learn about how much coins and bills are worth. Now use what you know as you ask customers to buy your cookies!

#### **Money Counts Leaf** (1 hour 30 minutes)

Pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters... oh, my! You'll get the chance to handle real money and learn about where it comes from. Play games to become more familiar with different types of coins, and go shopping in your own mini-mall! You'll learn what money is worth.

### **Making Choices Leaf** (1 hour 30 minutes)

Is your allowance burning a hole in your pocket? Learn how to spend it wisely through fun games and art projects, and then it's time to go shopping! You'll manage your own business with friends and shop for items to take home with you- but you have to stick to your budget!

## **Talk It Up Leaf** (2 hours)

## **Board Game Design Badge** (2 hours)

Engineers are people who like to know how things work. They design and build things people use every day, like computers, phones, roads, bridges and cars. They use their imaginations to solve problems and create new products. Create board games and engineer your own game spinner using GoldieBlox.

#### **Designing Robots Badge** (3 hours)

Join us and earn one of the brand NEW robotics badges! Learn how robots work, and how they imitate real animals in nature. Then design and BUILD your own robot to help animals! This program also covers the Brownie Design a Robot requirements.

#### **Model Car Design Badge** (2 hours)

When engineers design something new, they need to think about forces like gravity and friction. Friction is a force that slows and stops moving objects. Without friction, any object that was pushed or pulled would keep moving forever. Build a model car out of GoldieBlox and test the friction of your car on different surfaces to prepare for a Troop Car Chase!

## **Brownie Badge Workshops**

#### **Computer Expert** (3 hours)

Paint a magical picture using the computer. Go on an adventure to find cool facts on the internet. Create an email to send to friend or even the president!

## **Design a Robot** (3 hours)

Join us and earn one of the brand NEW robotics badges! Learn how robots work, and how they imitate real animals in nature. Then design and BUILD your own robot to help animals! This program also covers the Daisy Designing Robots requirements.

#### First Aid (2 hours)

Make your own first aid kit, hear from a first responder who helps injured people, practice calling 911 and gain some skills for treating and preventing injuries.

## **Girl Scout Way** (2 hours)

In this badge, try some special Brownie traditions (some that Girl Scouts have been sharing for 100 years!)—and, of course, have a world of Brownie fun.

## **Home Scientist** (2 hours)

Use items from your home to make slime, Mentos rockets and ice cream! Become a scientist by creating chemical reactions to earn the Home Scientist Badge.

## **Making Friends** (2 hours)

Make new friends, but keep the old. One is silver and the other's gold. Friends are another kind of family. They're the people you have fun with and who help you when you need it. Come to this badge workshop to learn how to make new friends, keep old friends and be the best Brownie you can be.

#### **Making Games** (2 hours)

You can have fun without a computer, a deck of cards or even a ball. Games are everywhere when you use your imagination to make them up! Try this badge workshop, and you and your friends will never be bored again.

#### **Money Manager** (2 hours)

Is your allowance burning a hole in your pocket? Learn how to spend it wisely through fun games and art projects, and then it's time to go shopping! You'll manage your own business with friends and shop for items to take home with you- but you have to stick to your budget!

#### **Philanthropist** (2 hours)

## **Senses** (1 hour and 30 minutes)

## **Junior Badge Workshops**

#### **Animal Habitats** (2 hours)

Imagine meeting a monkey or kicking up dust with a kangaroo. These animals live in the wild, so we don't get to spend time with them in their natural homes—their habitats. But that doesn't mean we can't find out more about where they live, how they play, and how we can help them!

#### **Detective** (2 hours)

Two hour program: Stories, movies and television are full of amazing detectives solving mysteries and bringing criminals to justice. Their jobs are important, exciting and take serious skills - skills you can try in this badge workshop. Grab your magnifying glass and dive into the science of detecting!

## **Digital Photographer** (3 hours)

Say Cheese! Learn the basics of photography and editing. Take pictures with your Girl Scout friends and try your hand in editing them. Create art with your photos and share them in an art show!

## **Entertainment Technology** (3 hours)

Turn your world 3D! Explore the entertainment industry and the technology used. Create a roller coaster, 3D glasses and animated artwork.

## First Aid (2 hours)

What would you do in an emergency? Find out the steps to take, learn about first responders who come to the aid of injured people, make your own first aid kit, and gain some know-how for handling urgent first aid issues and helping a sick person.

## **Girl Scout Way** (2 hours)

As a Girl Scout Junior, you're on an adventure to find your path through the world. Our sisterhood is full of traditions to help guide you. In this badge, share activities and spirit that's a century strong and growing stronger every day—because of Girl Scout stars like you!

#### **Playing the Past** (1 hour 30 minutes)

#### **Scribe** (3 hours)

Words are powerful tools. Great writing can make people feel encouraged, entertained or excited. It can create fantasy worlds or preserve events from history. And just writing down your feelings actually makes you feel better! In this badge workshop, find out what you can do with words.

## **Social Butterfly** (2 hours)

Have you ever found yourself in a group or place where you didn't know how to act? It happens to everyone. In this badge workshop, have fun practicing the social style and good manners that will make you comfortable in any situation.

## **Cadette Badge Workshops**

#### **Budgeting** (3 hours)

Do you have a savings account? How about a stock portfolio? Maybe you're saving up for a dream car or planning a big trip- or maybe you don't have the first idea of how to start saving. No matter where you are, you'll learn how to save, spend and give your money wisely through fun activities with friends.

#### **Comic Artist** (2 hours)

Calling all artists! Newspaper cartoons, comic books, graphic novels...comic art is a broad, exciting and growing field. At this badge workshop, you'll have the chance to share your story through the art of comics.

## **Comparison Shopping** (3 hours)

Figuring out how to manage your money as you get older is tough! You'll solve problems, play games and do role-playing activities to learn to decide what to buy and how to save for something big. You'll also go online to comparison shop and gain smart shopping skills!

## **Digital Movie Maker** (3 hours)

#### First Aid (2 hours)

#### **Girl Scout Way** (2 hours)

Talking in front of a group of people is an important skill for the rest of your life, whether you're auditioning for a school play, giving a speech or when your dream of becoming an actor? or teacher? or coach comes true. Practice these skills at this Public Speaker badge workshop!

#### **Screenwriter** (3 hours)

When it thrills, makes you laugh or has a fantastic twist, a movie or TV show can seem like magic. And a great show starts with a great script! Screenwriters write scripts meant to be filmed. ## **Fun Patch Programs**

#### **Girl Scout Adventures** (2 hours)

## Shop Missions (located at the Vernon Hills Gathering Place)
