

Note: Fully vaccinated means at least 2 weeks after 2nd shot of Pfizer/Moderna vaccinations, or at least 2 weeks after J&J 1-shot vaccination

Proof of Vaccination	Troop leaders have the right to ask for proof of vaccination. The council does not recommend the troop leader keeping a copy of the vaccination card. It is the responsibility of the parent and/or the girl to provide the proof of vaccination as needed.
Group Size (including adults)	<p>All groups meeting in a public place should follow the lower of the COVID-19 capacity guidelines, as determined by the venue or local government.</p> <p>If meeting in a private residence, the group size can be no greater than the number of people who can comfortably maintain physical distancing.</p> <p>Groups should follow adult:girl ratios as outlined in Safety Activity Checkpoint.</p>
Physical Distancing	<p>Groups in which all individuals are fully vaccinated: Physical distancing not required except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance.</p> <p>Groups that include individuals who are not fully vaccinated: Keep at least 6-feet of distance between each participant.</p>
Face Coverings	While the council has lifted its mask requirement, troop leaders have the right to require masks for in-person gatherings. Troop leaders, with the input of their members, will decide on any mask protocols that work best for their situations.
Snacks and Drinks	<p>Prepackaged snacks and drinks and personal water bottles prefilled at home recommended.</p> <p>Working on cooking badges and activities allowed. Frequent hand washing should be practiced by all participants during preparation and eating.</p> <p>Eating and drinking outside strongly encouraged.</p>
Virtual Meetings	Safest option
Outdoor Meetings/ Gatherings	Strongly recommended
Indoor Meetings/ Gatherings	Allowed in spaces with adequate ventilation and space to accommodate physical distancing. Outdoor meetings and gatherings strongly recommended.
Meetings at Private Residences (Indoor and Outdoor)	<p>Council pre-approval requirements for meeting in a private residence are temporarily lifted as we understand that finding space to meet is challenging. An email must still be sent to meetingathome@girlscoutsgcnwi.org with the name of the troop or other group planning to meet at a home, the homeowner's name, address of the property and proof of insurance.</p> <p>In meeting in a private residence, you also agree to take the same precautions as before. Refer to the Meeting Locations section of the detailed guidelines below.</p>
Travel and Overnight Stays	<p>Council approval required for all travel and overnight stays through the usual Trip and Travel approval process.</p> <p>Groups in which all individual are fully vaccinated: Domestic and international travel allowed.</p> <p>Groups that include individuals who are not fully vaccinated: Travel and overnight stays discouraged. Troop leaders, with input from their members, will decide on any COVID-19 precautions that best work for their situations. Recommend delaying international travel until all participants are fully vaccinated.</p> <p>For all international travel: Pay close attention to the situation at international destinations, as it could change quickly. Monitor vaccine and testing requirements, as well as any COVID protocols necessary. Be aware of current CDC re-entry requirements for all air passengers arriving in the U.S.</p>
