

DELEGATE POSITION DESCRIPTION

Each Delegate shall:

- Attend service unit, district, and council meetings, including the council's Annual Meeting
- As requested, make recommendations on behalf of the service unit and/or district to the board and/or other committees on governance matters, through the District Chair
- Communicate to the service unit and/or district about governance matters, actions taken
 by the board and/or other committees, and other information as requested by the District
 Chair

Terms of Office

- Each Delegate shall serve for a term of two (2) years or until a successor is selected and assumes office.
- There are no limits on the number of terms a delegate may serve
- Terms of office shall begin on March 1

Qualifications:

- Must be a registered member of Girl Scouts of the USA in the current program year
- Must be 14 years of age or older at the time the term of office begins on March 1
