

Service Unit Approved Awards Nomination Form

The following awards are approved at the Service Unit level and are typically presented in the order they appear below.

New Found Treasure Award

This GCNWI specific award recognizes a Girl Scout adult who has been registered for **less than two years** and has hit the ground running. This person has made a positive impact on Girl Scouting and their performance is so outstanding that it merits recognition.

-Nomination plus one signature of support required

Shining Star (formerly Hidden Hero)

This GCNWI specific award recognizes a Girl Scout adult who embodies the Girl Scout principle "to help where I am needed". This volunteer has gone above and beyond assisting in special projects, ongoing tasks, and support of Girl Scout programs in this person's Service Unit, Troop or other program delivery group. They continually accept new assignments to keep Girl Scouts thriving.

-Nomination plus one signature of support required

Volunteer of Excellence

This GSUSA award recognizes a Girl Scout adult who has contributed outstanding service while partnering directly with Girl Scouts in any pathway to implement the Girl Scout Leadership Experience through use of the national program portfolio, or who have contributed outstanding service in support of the council's mission delivery to members.

-Nomination plus one Letter of Endorsement required

The process for nomination is as follows:

- -Nominators complete this form and return it to their Service Unit Team. Each Service Unit is allowed to set their own deadline for receiving nominations. Typically the date is in the Spring.
- -The Service Unit Team, or designated volunteers within the Service Unit, accept, review and approve nominations.
- -Once approved, the Service Unit will report awardees to the council and can request pins using the SU Award Request and Reporting Form available at www.girlscoutsgcnwi.org/recognition
- -Pins and PDF certificates are provided at no cost to the Service Unit. The Service Unit is responsible for notifying and presenting of awards.
