Guidelines:

- Troop members must create one ornament per person.
- Before submitting your ornaments, all submissions, whether they are submitted as a troop or an individual, must complete the Ornament Submission Form. Those who do not complete the form will not receive their fun patches.

- *All ornaments must be dropped off at a Girl Scouts GCNWI Gathering Place near you before **October 26**.*

All ornaments must adhere to these guidelines.

Ornaments that use items that are listed as "not acceptable" will not be displayed on the tree, per Brookfield Zoo regulations.
