



District Delegate and Delegate-at-Large Position Description

Each Delegate shall:

- Attend district and council meetings, including Delegate Quarterly Meetings and the council's Annual Meeting
- District Delegates will also attend meetings of Service Unit they represent
- As requested, make recommendations on behalf of the service unit and/or district to the board and/or other committees on governance matters, through the District Chair
- Communicate to the service unit and/or district about governance matters, actions taken by the board and/or other committees, and other information as requested.

Terms of Office:

- Each Delegate shall serve for a term of two (2) years or until a successor is selected and assumes office
- There is no term limits on the number of terms a delegate may serve
- Delegates may be brought on throughout the year but must be in place at least one (1) month prior to the Annual Meeting or two (2) weeks before a Delegate Quarterly Meeting to be able to vote on any business during those meetings.

Qualifications:

- Must be a registered member of Girl Scouts of Greater Chicago and Northwest Indiana
- Must be at least 14 years of age or older at time of selection
- District Delegates are selected by the Service Unit and must be reported to the District Chair or through democraticprocess@girlscoutsgcnwi.org to ensure they are added to the roster
- Delegates-at-large are selected by the District Chair
