Hall of Fame

The Hall of Fame award is presented to candidates who have been an adult member for at least 25 years, have delivered service that far exceeds the expectations of any position and have had a lasting impact on the Girl Scout organization.

Donna Barnish, Melrose Park, IL Linda Pote, Lockport, IL

Donna Barnish Hall of Fame In 1964 Donna Barnish became a Brownie Girl Scout in Chicago during second grade at the urging of a school friend and after begging her mother for weeks to allow her to join. Ceremonies, friends, service projects, pride in wearing a uniform, the promise of camping, earnable badges, and other fun activities kept her coming back.

Donna recalls two leaders who impressed and inspired her. One was Mrs. Roberts, her Junior leader, who handled a well-intentioned action on Donna's part in a kind manner. Her troop was making crossword puzzle books for hospitalized veterans. Donna didn't realize there was a deadline and procrastinated several months until she was bored and had nothing else to do. She turned in a couple books at the next meeting quite proud of herself. Near the end of the meeting, Mrs. Roberts made a point of how important timeliness was in completing projects. She never mentioned Donna by name and never looked her way while she talked, but Donna got the message loud and clear. A lesson she would never forget: if you're going to do anything in this world, DO IT or don't!

Another inspirational leader for Donna was Mrs. Lydia DePolo. After just one year, the troop's Cadette leader moved on. The girls begged Mrs. DePolo to take over the troop. She finally agreed. At their first meeting, she said to the troop, "You're Cadettes. What do you want to do as Cadette Girl Scouts?" They replied, "Go camping!" She then directed the girls

to decide where they were going, when were they going, and how they would get there. She put it all on the girls to do the research and plan the whole trip (without the availability of internet), and they did! Donna considers this opportunity to be one of her truly GREAT learning experiences.

During her three years (1965-1967) as a Junior Girl Scout, Donna earned 29 proficiency badges as well as the four signs. As a Cadette Girl Scout (1968 -1970), she earned 28 proficiency badges, her four Challenge Pins and became a First Class Scout.

There were more memorable experiences during Donna's years as a Senior Girl Scout. The troop did a lot of singing. Christmas caroling, nursing home entertainment and other service projects to fill their time. They cleaned up Chicago beaches in honor of Earth Day and had their photo and story on the front page of the Chicago Tribune. They also participated in the Chicago Senior Conference, "Let it Begin with Me", in 1971, as well as the District 6 Look Wide. Donna was also selected as a Girl Scout Public Relations person and had her photo taken with Benny the Bull after a Flag Ceremony at the start of a Bulls game. Additionally, she participated in a Flag Ceremony at the 1973 Governor's Dinner.

As many others before her, Donna took on the role of Girl Scout leader when her first daughter became a Daisy Girl Scout in 1996. At the end of her first year, she realized that she was in it for the long haul and decided to become a lifetime member. A good investment as it turned out! Over her 26 years as a leader, she has taken on multiple troops and levels whenever the need arose. Donna's philosophy is that no girl should be denied a chance to be, or have to quit being, a Girl Scout just because enough adults can't see their way clear to lead. Donna has found that if she asks for help, parents will come through for her.

Donna took on other roles for Lone Tree Council because she felt that personal leader advice and guidance weren't readily available to the volunteers. She took whatever trainings were available for her to serve her girls. She ran the Girl Scout Religious Awards program in her parish, Sacred Heart of Melrose Park, and was the recruiter/organizer there for many years. The trainings allowed her to earn a total of six Leadership Green Leaves and one Silver Leaf for her Leadership Development Pin. In 2000 she was awarded the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Medal, and in 2002, the St. Anne Award for her service in the Religious Award Program and her parish. In 2012 she was awarded the Outstanding Leader Pin from her service unit.

When Lone Tree became part of the Illinois Crossroads Council, Donna found the personal service to be lacking. She is happy that she began with Lone Tree because she learned so much during those years that sustained her through the many transitions from doing everything in person to doing almost everything online. Donna feels so much is being lost

without the personal contact, stories, and experiences others have to share.

During her high school years, Donna applied to volunteer for the Muscular Dystrophy Summer Camp program. She was chosen over 15 other applicants from her high school because she was a Girl Scout! She continued serving at the summer camps for about 18 years. Through the camp program, she came to know people from all over the city and suburbs, worked the Labor Day Weekend Telethons, helped at parties for adults and children with Muscular Dystrophy, and eventually served as the Youth Group President. After college, Donna became a member of the Chicago MDA Board, served as Secretary and spent two years as president. As an adult, Donna has put all that singing she did as a Senior Girl Scout to good use within her parish. She has sung with the parish's guitar groups and choirs, eventually becoming a cantor at masses. She also started a children's choir for the parish school. Many of her Girl Scouts were in the choir over the years.

It's with great pleasure that we welcome Donna Barnish into the Girl Scouts of Greater Chicago and Northwest Indiana Hall of Fame!

Linda Pote Hall of Fame When examining the involvement of Linda Pote with Girl Scouts, it is obvious that she has been one of our most dedicated members. Her relationship with the movement started in 1955 when she joined as a Brownie in the South Cook County Council and continued as a girl member until her sophomore year of high school. There was a very sad

circumstance that ended her girl years. Helen Page was the leader of Linda's troop as Intermediates and then into Seniors. However, Helen passed away during Linda's freshman year of high school. No viable leader stepped forward, so the troop disbanded during their sophomore year. Linda still has such fond memories of Helen and has deep admiration for her leadership qualities.

Linda also has warm recollections of Camp Manistee, a South Cook County property that was located in Michigan. She remembers doing all sorts of fund-raising activities with her troop mates to earn the money needed for the resident camp fees. She also enjoyed the time that a family weekend took place at Manistee and considers it to be one of her most memorable experiences in Girl Scouting. During her girl years, Linda was proud of her accomplishments, such as earning numerous badges and receiving the Marian Medal.

As an adult, Linda was part of the Trailways Council. She served as a national council delegate for two National Council Sessions, although she attended a total of nine

conventions. At the 1981 convention, what really stood out to Linda and other delegates were the meals – it seemed that every one of them included chicken, even on the flights to and from NCS! To highlight the unusual lack of meal variation they had to endure at NCS, the delegates made chicken costumes to wear at the council's annual meeting. They even presented the council president with the "Golden Chicken Award". The NCS chicken fiasco provided many hilarious moments for the delegates.

Linda attributes her Girl Scout involvement with preparing her for leadership because of the many learning opportunities and trainings she received. She recalls the excellent instruction she obtained at the Macy Center, which gave her so much insight into fulfilling her role as the council president for Trailways. She even took a speech class to help her gain more confidence when doing public speaking, which was vital to her council president duties.

Besides her five years as the Trailways Council President and her two terms as a national council delegate, Linda has held numerous other Girl Scout positions. She was a Junior and Cadette leader, a day camp counselor, a member of the board of directors and served on the council's nominating committee. She also worked as a Trailways staff member for 14 years in the position of fund development director. Today, Linda is a valued member of the council historians, and she is instrumental in preserving legacy Trailways Council history.

Linda's dedication to the movement has not gone unnoticed. She is the recipient of the Appreciation Pin, the Thanks Badge, and the Leo Faulstich Award, a recognition named in honor of a Trailways board member. At the end of her presidency, Linda was presented with a lovely quilt made up of individual squares, each square created by a different troop in Trailways Council.

Outside of Girl Scouts, Linda also volunteers for the Will County Center for Community Concerns, a non-for-profit which assists low income individuals to obtain the opportunities needed to prepare themselves for self-sufficiency. She has worked with this organization for thirty years, and chaired its board for five years.

For all that Linda Pote has done for Girl Scouts, she truly deserves to be inducted into the Girl Scouts of Greater Chicago and Northwest Indiana Hall of Fame!



Thanks Badge II

Veronica Pradelski Thanks Badge II Girl Scouts is very fortunate to have Veronica Pradelski as one of its most enthusiastic volunteers for the past 34 years. During her youth, she started out as a Brownie in the Chicago Council. Camping was pivotal for Veronica throughout this time. As a Junior, she truly enjoyed the southeast Chicago summer day camp which included cooking, crafts, and

singing. She also recalls the fun encampments she experienced at Camp Butternut Springs. During her time as a Cadette, Veronica really admired her two leaders, Lorraine Sawyer and Althea Carrier. She was impressed by the fact that neither of these volunteers had children of their own, and yet they were willing to lead her troop. These leaders wanted the troop to have memorable experiences, so they encouraged the girls to earn money for an extended trip. Veronica particularly remembers the successful spaghetti dinner the troop organized as a fund raiser. Along with their proceeds from the cookie sale, her troop earned enough money for a bus trip to Philadelphia. Seeing the Liberty Bell made the hard work (and long bus ride) worth it!

Sadly, Veronica was unable to move up to Seniors because her father had passed away. However, Veronica feels that her years as a girl member gave her the confidence to do things that she wouldn't have otherwise tried. For instance, she took a trip to California with some college friends even though she had never flown before.

Once she had daughters of her own, Veronica wanted them to also have some of the same

experiences that she had loved while growing up. When her daughter Beth was old enough to become a Daisy, there weren't enough leaders. Veronica knew that it was now time for her to become a volunteer. She jumped in with both feet and has never looked back, serving as a troop leader from 1989 to 2005. But being a troop leader was not the only way Veronica found to volunteer. Over the years, she has held positions on her service unit team, including service unit manager. She has also served as a national council delegate and as a member of the 100th Anniversary Service Task Group. Additionally, she has been a long-time member of adult recognitions, serving on both the review team and the events team. This past year, Veronica was a dedicated volunteer for the Packs of Love for Ukrainian Children service project.

However, probably the most time consuming position currently held by Veronica is that of council historian. She was totally excited when in 2005 she received a scholarship from the Girl Scouts of South Cook County to attend a workshop for history preservation at Macy Center. This opportunity opened up her eyes as to what historians from across the country were doing, and Veronica realized this was something which she would absolutely want to do for Girl Scouts. Since that workshop, Veronica has been a tireless advocate for historical preservation of the Girl Scout movement, both locally and nationally. She would be the first one to tell you that her involvement with the council historians has been one of the most rewarding aspects of her Girl Scout volunteering.

Besides her work on behalf of Girl Scouts, Veronica is also a very active member of Christ Our Savior Parish in South Holland, where she serves as a eucharist minister.



Years of Service

Roger Anderson, Jr. 60 Years of Service

If the names Roger and Sis Anderson sound familiar to you, that means that you have either been involved in Girl Scouting a long time, or you have seen the sign dedicating the lake to the couple at the front of Camp Butternut Springs (BNS). They were caretakers of our camp over 70 years ago. We now have the privilege of celebrating their son, Roger

Anderson, Jr. He was in high school when his parents moved him and his sister Joy into the house that still sits on property. That's when the family began their work with thousands of Girl Scout campers.

Roger Jr. is receiving a 60 year pin for his much accomplished love for and work on our property. He did odd jobs around camp whenever his parents requested his assistance. He grew to love the out-of-doors and to respect scouting. He himself was an Eagle Scout and then worked with Indian Princesses in a town where Girl Scouting wasn't offered. He even worked at Camp Owasapee.

His fondest memory of being the caretaker's kid was helping his dad with garbage detail. Roger would dress up in costume, and the girls loved it! You never knew which Roger you would get coming to collect your garbage. He also remembers the white frogs we had at BNS. (They would get in the chlorinated pool, swim out, and remain white!) Roger Jr. attributes his customer service skills to working at camp. He recently retired from IBM after experiencing a wonderful career.

He currently lives in nearby Plymouth, Indiana and visits the camp at least once a year with his family to rekindle the memories.



Phyllis Drewno 55 Years of Service Although Phyllis Drewno was never a girl member, she became a devoted Girl Scout as an adult in 1967. Her volunteer career started with the responsibility of neighborhood cookie chair for Lansing, which was at the time part of Legacy Girl Scouts of Calumet Council. Evelyn Linn, the council president, inspired her to get involved.

Phyllis remembers that Evelyn gave so much to Girl Scouts even though she herself didn't have any daughters of her own. Evelyn encouraged Phyllis to start a troop, since she had three daughters who would benefit from the values. Evelyn's mentoring had such a huge impact on Phyllis that she took Evelyn's advice and became a leader in 1970, starting her first Junior troop. Phyllis remained in that position for all three of her daughters for a total of 15 years. She became a lifetime member due in large part to the support she received from Evelyn. She started volunteering in Calumet Council with whatever they needed and never hesitated to take on new challenges, including the position of council cookie chair and then starting the QSP/Candy Program which she chaired for 13 years. Over her many years as a volunteer, Phyllis has held every neighborhood role and a good number at the council level, too. She made a long term commitment to the Calumet Council Board of Directors, giving nearly 20 years. Along with her multitude of other Girl Scout positions, she worked the shop for two years and was manager for eight years. Today she continues to serve in a variety of ways, such as, SU 636 secretary, alternate delegate, council historian, adult recognitions events task group member, and assisting as needed whenever and wherever she can for Girl Scout events.

When Phyllis reflects on her experiences for over five decades, she is most appreciative of being able to watch her Girl Scouts grow and become amazing young adults. She knows that a good number of her former troop members are now passing on the Girl Scout experiences to their own daughters and granddaughters, since they have let her know what an impact she had on them as their leader. The realization that she has played a role in bringing Girl Scouting to the future generation of girls has given Phyllis a great deal of satisfaction.

Phyllis is thankful for countless fond memories and humorous moments provided by her Girl Scouts. She recalls one crazy incident that involved her Ford Fairlane 500 and some very "flexible" girls. Since this was a large vehicle, her troop wanted to "do some math". They wanted to find out the maximum passenger capacity for the car. With Phyllis in the driver's seat, they piled in EVERYWHERE. The conclusion was that her car could actually hold 13 people! She remembers how much they all laughed trying to get out!

However, Phyllis recounts that her favorite memory was when she took her troop to a dude

ranch at Bass Lake. One of her girls was afraid to ride a horse because her sister had fallen off a few years before, and she was worried that the same thing would happen to her. Phyllis convinced her that she wouldn't fall off. Well, she did fall, but she wasn't hurt. With true Girl Scout courage and confidence, she got back up and finished her ride, had a good time, and both sisters could laugh about something they both shared.

For her dedication to Girl Scouts, Phyllis has received numerous awards, including Appreciation Pin, Honor Pin, Thanks Badge, Thanks Badge II, and Hall of Fame 2013. In addition, she was recognized in 2012 as one of the Women of the Century for Girl Scouts of Greater Chicago and Northwest Indiana.

Besides her substantial volunteer commitment to Girl Scouts, Phyllis has been an extraordinary community volunteer as well. She's secretary/treasurer for Sears "Best" Retirees Group, a member of South Suburban Genealogy and Historical Society, a researcher for Pullman when asked, and a member of both the Lansing Historical Society and Calumet City Historical Society. She also helps at a few local churches when asked to assist in special events. In 2009 and again in 2012, Phyllis was awarded Volunteer of the Year for Lansing. Additionally, she has been honored as Lady of the Year for the Columbian Ladies Club.



Carolyn (Lauing) Finzer 55 Years of Service Carolyn is a fourth generation Napervillian, artist, teacher, professional storyteller, environmental activist, community volunteer and Girl Scouts of the USA Facilitator doing seasonal programs. She graduated from St. Peter & Paul Parochial school, where her mother led her Brownie and Girl Scout Troop 427. She was one of the first

DuPage County Council Girl Scouts to attend summer resident Camp Chippewa Bay (New Auburn, WI), where she learned canoeing skills. Her childhood troop camped at the Indiana Sand Dunes Tipi Town, Camp Greene Wood and Camp VonOven. She earned her Marian Medal in eighth grade.

She was a leader in many arenas in high school , with outstanding artistic talents. She graduated from Illinois State University with a B.S. in Art Education and a dance minor.

She returned to Naperville, teaching grades K-12 until her first daughter was born. Carolyn went for Girl Scout leadership training, including pilot programming for the Daisy level in 1985, and led two troops weekly for 12 years. She also volunteered as a Pottawatomie Legends and Lore storyteller at service unit jamborees, and served as Nature Lady and Arts and Crafts co-director at Camp VonOven.

Her family took a trip to Savannah, Georgia, one spring break to visit Juliette Low's birthplace and grave site. In 1993, they visited Lord Baden Powell's London, England Boy Scout headquarters to honor the "roots of scouting." When Girl Scouting turned 100 in 2012, Carolyn led a parade of current and former Girl Scouts in a jubilant summer Naperville Municipal Band concert parade with flags and banners as "The Girl Scout March," composed and copyrighted by director Ron Keller, was played. She illustrated a historic architectural walking tour booklet for Girl Scouts working on the My Heritage badge, and was a valued resource-presenter at Naper Settlement and the Morton Arboretum over the decades.

Carolyn received the Naperville Jaycees Distinguished Service award twice, the Illinois State University Outstanding Service Award, the St. Peter & Paul Distinguished Graduate Award and the Conservation Foundation 2004 Paul Butler Memorial Award.

In 2001, Carolyn made a Naperville United Way fiberglass benefit auction sculpture. "DAISY" the Girl Scout Giraffe, features badges and patches in place of brown spots and now resides in the Brookfield Zoo Hamill Family Children's Pavilion for all to meet and greet ("Make new friends but keep the old"). She has also worked on Century Walk public

art installations, painted a street mural, judged youth and adult art gallery shows. She caretakes five public gardens, including the International Peace Pole within Veterans Park, and, in 2022, she supervised the restoration of the 100-year-old Stone Grotto at the St. Peter & Paul Cemetery (her Grandpa Art Miller was one of the original builders of this historic structure).

Carolyn and her husband Mel have a 1-acre yard registered with the National Wildlife Federation, the WILD ONES; the Conservation At Home program; Monarch Watch through the University of Kansas; the Illinois Audubon Society Bird & Butterfly habitat program; Sierra Club, and the Xerces Society. They were featured in Bird & Blooms and Chicagoland Gardening magazine. Her camp name is "Violet" after the Illinois State Flower.

Heidi Gannon 55 Years of Service Heidi started her Girl Scout journey with the Chicago Council in 1946 when she joined an Intermediate (Junior) Girl Scout troop. During her time as a girl member, she recalls earning lots of badges and also her First Class Award. She stayed in Girl Scouts during her high school years because of the camaraderie, good program, and love of the girls she met

along the way. Heidi remembers all the fun she had in Girl Scouts with her troop, including a Halloween scavenger hunt in the neighborhood and all the crazy items they had to find.

Another fun memory for her was camping at Camp Thorn Creek in Glenwood as a Girl Scout, even though it was freezing cold. She also enjoyed selling lots of Girl Scout cookies during the annual cookie sale. She spent so many hours going door-to-door trying to sell as many cookies as she could. Then one year her dad told her to give him the order form. He took it to work, and Heidi ended up being the top cookie seller for her troop! She was thrilled!

Heidi became an adult member in the Dolton Association for the South Cook County Council when her daughter joined a troop. Heidi was a troop leader from 1967-1979; a service unit manager (at that time known as an association chair) in the seventies; on the South Cook County Council Board of Directors in the eighties and nineties; and a national council delegate for several Girl Scout conventions. She also served on South Cook County Council's Nominating Committee, along with being a council trainer, and serving on various committees. Heidi continues to serve today in her role as a council historian, working to preserve the history of the former South Cook County Girl Scouts.

Heidi has received many of the adult Girl Scout awards, including the Appreciation Pin, Honor Pin, Thanks Badge and Thanks Badge II from the South Cook County Council. She was inducted into the Girl Scouts of Greater Chicago and Northwest Indiana Hall of Fame in 2019.

Outside of Girl Scouts, Heidi also served as a Boy Scout den mother, a volunteer in her church infant program and was a former census taker. For over 20 years, she has participated with BSF (Bible Study Fellowship), acting as a leader of the group for several of those years.



Peggy Sinko 55 Years of Service Peggy Sinko started her long association with Girls Scouts as a Brownie in Calumet Council in 1956. She stayed with Troop 292 through her high school years, earning the Curve Bar along the way. She has been a continuous member ever since, receiving her 65 year numeral guard in 2022. Peggy attributes her dear leaders Mrs. Margaret Lewallen and

Mrs. Martha Egyed as having a tremendous impact on all of the Girl Scouts of her troop. As a group of working class girls from Hammond, the experiences provided by their troop leaders helped to influence their life choices, resulting in many accomplished women.

As a girl member, Peggy discovered her love of camping and the out-of-doors. She really enjoyed summer camp at Camp Tocanja in Michigan. Her camp friends have stayed connected though the Tocanja Facebook page. Recently, Peggy had lunch with an old camp buddy who was passing through town, which resulted in lots of laughs and good memories from over 60 years ago. One of those memories was a Camp Tocanja canoe trip where Peggy's group successfully navigated a challenging section of the river which was full of rocks and snags. All of this was in view of a group of Boy Scouts whom they had just watched crash and tip over. It was a very big sense of achievement as the girls paddled by the dripping boys!

Other standout memories form Peggy's girl years include a troop trip to Washington, DC in 1963, the 1965 Roundup in Idaho, serving as president of Calumet Council Senior Planning Board, being a Camp Tocanja CIT (counselor in training), and working as a camp counselor.

Much of what Peggy learned from her Girl Scout experiences carried over into her adult life. As a troop, they valued their successes because they had worked together to make them happen. But they also learned to deal with unpredictability and to realize that things don't always go according to plan. Often those "unplanned" events turned out to be some of the most memorable. Troop 292 had the infamous "spaghetti incident." Since then, none of the troop members has put spaghetti into water that wasn't boiling! Decades later at a troop reunion, every one of the "girls" remembered the "spaghetti incident," even though the leaders had no recollection of it.

As an adult member, Peggy has taken on numerous positions, including Board Member for Loan Tree Council in the eighties and nineties, Chair of the Lone Tree self-evaluation task force, various service unit positions, and council historian. For her service, she has received numerous recognitions: Thanks Badge from Lone Tree Council (1995); Beamon-Denoyer Award from Illinois Crossroads, (2004); GCNWI Women of the Century Award (2012); Girl

Scout Hidden Heroine from GCNWI SU 409 (2013); Girl Scout Honor Pin from GCNWI, SU 409 (2017). Peggy is also a member of the Juliette Gordon Low Society.

Outside of Girl Scouts, Peggy is a dedicated volunteer with the Historical Society of Oak Park and River Forest, including a longtime board member and has just completed five years as board president. She curated Girl Scout History exhibits at the Museum in 2012 and 2020-23. She has received two awards from the Historical Society of Oak Park and River Forest, the Faye Devine Award as Outstanding Volunteer (2004) and the Philander Barclay Award given for exemplifying the love of local history (2012). Peggy is also active with Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Oak Park.

Theresa Arneson 50 Years of Service

Theresa Arneson has had a varied and full adult life in Girl Scouts. Although she was never in Girl Scouts as a girl, she has been very active as an adult.

She began working in the Indiana Lakeland Council in Elkhart, Indiana in 1974. Her positions included unit leader, resident camp director and field director.

Theresa was also Director of Camping Services at Singing Sands Council until 1985, which included directing water front programs. In 1986 until the 2008 GCNWI merger, Theresa was CEO of Trailways Girl Scout Council in Joliet.

Theresa's interest in Girl Scouting has always been the outdoors. A favorite memory was the time when she and the girls were able to interview and talk with the great granddaughter of Juliette Gordon Low at camp.

Theresa strongly feels that volunteers are the true backbone of Girl Scouts. Her experiences in working with volunteers helped her to develop effective communication and organizational skills.

In addition to being a registered member for 50 years, Theresa has received numerous adult recognitions up to and including the Thanks Badge II. She also served on the World Council Staff during the eighties, and was honored by the Ottawa United Way organization. Theresa currently is actively involved with the Meals on Wheels and United Way organizations in her community.

Ruta Valdmanis Jensen 50 Years of Service Ruta Valdmanis Jensen has been in Girl Scouts since the age of 10 years old and earned her Curved Bar. She has been a member of Wichita Area Girl Scout Council, DuPage County Council, and Girl Scouts of Greater Chicago and Northwest Indiana.

She reflects that she was inspired by Ms. Peterson, who was also known as "Pete." Pete was a leader for the CIT Wichita Area Council and was known for being really cool with the Girls Scouts in grades 10-12 and was known for saying, "I don't want to hear any of that grumbling." The experience of being a Girl Scout has kept Ruta in Girl Scouting. She has served as a camp counselor and really appreciated her time earning badges. She looks back on one of her most significant Girl Scout experiences being a participant to the Casanova New York State Conference where she met one of the original British Girl Scouts!

She feels that the skills you learn in Girl Scouting are useful throughout your whole life. Girl Scouts learn to work through things, plan projects, work with other people and how to lead both in and outside of Girl Scouts.

Maryann Reiter 50 Years of Service Maryann became a Brownie at Washington School in Downers Grove in 1957 and stayed through high school where she was a member of Senior Mariner Ship 167, DuPage County Council. In 1971 through Troops on Foreign Soil Council, she led a Cadette troop on an Army Base in Babenhausen, Germany. She lived in Hillsdale, MI for ten

years and was a board member of the Irish Hills Council. She returned to Illinois in 2010 and joined the Girl Scouts of Greater Chicago and Northwest Indiana Council.

Maryann reflects that she stayed in Girl Scouts because of the people and the opportunities. She loves the sisterhood, the kids, the out-of-doors, the music, the food and the fun.

When asked who inspired her, she shared that that is like asking her who her favorite child is. But one name that stands out for her and countless others is Lis Christensson. Maryann believes she is one of the most incredible women on the planet and is convinced she knows everything, and she shares it beautifully.

Maryann has two special Girl Scout experiences that she will always remember. When her daughter was in the midst of wedding planning, one detail that was overlooked was the

need for ushers. As they were attending to the final touches, the day of her daughter's wedding, into the sanctuary came about eight dear still active Girl Scout friends, now in their twenties. They came to be the ushers and did a fabulous job!

But Maryann's favorite Girl Scout story of all times took place in the summer of 2005. She volunteered in Kenya, Africa, at an orphanage for children who had lost their parents to AIDS. Her time there led to many invitations and opportunities to meet people. One time, she was wearing a jacket with a small Girl Scout pin. At one reception, she turned around and extended her right hand to a young woman as they were being introduced. The other women, smiled and shook her head. She reached out with her left hand and raised the appropriate three fingers on her right hand. She was wearing a Kenya Girl Guide shirt. Maryann will never forget her smile or the moment they exchanged the universal WAGGGS greeting.

She reflects that she certainly learned a lot of life skills in Girl Scouts, but what she is really grateful for are the opportunities she has had as an adult volunteer. Maryann has held many positions, including leader, assistant leader, day camp Staff at Camp Greene Wood, program support, DuPage County Council Nominating Committee, Irish Hills Girl Scout Council Board of Directors, Cadette/Senior jamboree judge, cookie booth chair, outdoor trainer and many others! She is a lifetime member and has received the Thanks Badge. She currently assists with Girl Scouts as needed and is also involved with Kiwanis and Western DuPage Special Recreation Association.
